The Portland Trail Blazers got a mini-rapture this season when Miles Plumlee's nonchalant floater led to a three-pointer by J.J. Hickson on the buzzer. It was a fun moment, and of course the Blazers were thrilled at the prospect of upsetting the Oklahoma City Thunder. But here's something you don't see in the playoffs: a goal-scorer with a clear look at a game-winner. Good news for the Trail Blazers: They'll get more of that sort of production from the starting frontcourt duo of Zach Randolph and LaMarcus Aldridge in the first round of the playoffs. Portland opened the season with a 6-foot-11 behemoth from South Dakota State named Julius Randle. But after Randle's freak injury in a Nov. 5 game against the Suns, his brother LaMarcus, who also played at South Dakota State, came to Portland and played well in a limited number of games. Now, a full summer and some growing pains later, Randle is starting to show why the Blazers were so excited about him when they selected him sixth overall in the 2013 NBA Draft. Randle's presence has added an entire new dimension to the Blazers' offense. Whereas he previously showed a natural aptitude for rebound and block shots, his touch has improved dramatically this season, with good feet and positioning. He also has a true nose for the ball, whether it's in the high post or on the perimeter, and he's hitting jumpers from nearly anywhere on the court. It's been particularly helpful to him in the NBA's new "Small Ball" culture. This season, when the Trail Blazers go small, a lot of the work is done by the frontcourt duo of Randolph and Aldridge. And they're thriving with the big guys on the bench. From late last season through the All-Star break, Aldridge was mostly lost in the Blazers' starting lineup with power forward Thomas Robinson. The switch to 6-foot-11, 250-pound Randle was a mostly seamless one for Aldridge, who was able to find his touch and spot-up game better than ever. In

Sri Lanka's first medical school in 26 years can start opening in May after a licensing committee has cleared the way for it to start teaching on Jan. 15, 2017. According to The Sunday Times, the university will start to offer classes at a temporary facility at the Royal College in Colombo. The university is expected to have 150 students over its first year, and an intake of 200 in subsequent years. In September, the university's governing council granted permission to start formal teaching and research. The university will admit 50 in the initial batch, the report said. "Initially, we will only offer four subjects for the bachelor degree," professor Arunasena Wijesinghe, who is the university's vice chancellor, told the Times. (AP/File) The paper notes that Sri Lanka has been unable to produce doctors since the outbreak of the country's civil war in 1983, and violence flared up again in 2014. From 2006 until 2010, academic life was suspended after the end of a civil war that lasted a decade. "All the examinations are a must," said Wijesinghe, who has worked for more than four decades to set up the medical school. "But it will be a long process. It is a big step forward." The medical school is the first in Sri Lanka since it was established in 1978. One of its main aims will be to lower the number of medical students graduating from the country's universities, thus alleviating a health crisis in the country. Only 20 of Sri Lanka's 39 provincial medical faculties are currently training doctors. The country expects 150,000 new doctors by 2018, according to the World Health Organization, yet by the end of 2010 only a scant 7,884 doctors were able to treat the population
